Websites and apps that prescribe birth control and emergency contraception after an assessment or consultation. A prescription is mailed to you.



METHODS YOU CAN GET ON YOUR OWN WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION

These are methods you can buy on your own. You do not need to call your provider or have a consultation to get these methods.

BIRTH CONTROL PILLS



Need Refill: Call your provider's office to send refills to your pharmacy

Starting the Pill: Have a telemedicine visit with your provider. At the end they can send a prescription to your pharmacy

Options: Nurx, SimpleHealth, GoodRx Care, The Pill Club, Lemonaid, PlushCare, Alpha, BlinkHealth, Wisp, Hers, PRJKT Ruby



Starting the Patch: Have a telemedicine visit with your provider. At the end they can send a prescription to your pharmacy







PLAN B



If you would like a prescription for Plan B so that your insurance will pay for it, call your provider's office and ask them to send a prescription to your pharmacy **Options:** Nurx, Alpha, SimpleHealth, BlinkHealth, The Pill Club, Wisp



You can get Plan B over the counter (no prescription) online and in person at pharmacies, big box stores, and Amazon

DIAPHRAGM *use with spermicide



Need Another: Call your provider's office to send a prescription to your pharmacy

Starting the Diaphragm: For the diaphragms that come in different sizes, you must be fitted in-person. The Caya Single Size Diaphragm does not require an in-person visit, but does require a prescription from your provider

App does not exist for diaphragms



Cannot access on your own

CERVICAL CAP *use with spermicide



Need Another: Call your provider's office to send a prescription to your pharmacy

Starting the Cervical Cap: You can't start the cap without a visit—caps come in different sizes, you must be fitted

App does not exist for cervical caps

CONDOMS (INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL) *only way to prevent against STIs



If you would like a prescription for condoms so that your insurance will pay for them, call your provider's office and ask them to send a prescription to your pharmacy Options: SimpleHealth, GoodRx
Care, and The Pill Club



You can get condoms over the counter (no prescription) online and in person at pharmacies, big box stores, Amazon, and at www.condomania.com

FERTILITY AWARENESS METHOD (FAM)



No need to interact with a provider
